WEST WALES REGION JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT (PENTATHLON) MEET Saturday 16th June 2018

This meet will be swum under the following rules and conditions: FINA Technical Rules, Swim Wales Laws, West Wales Junior Development Meet Conditions.

MEET INFORMATION

- 1. In order to qualify for overall placing in the Junior Development (Pentathlon) Meet, swimmers need to enter the four stroke events and the Individual Medley. Swimmers who enter less than the 5 events will only be swimming for a 'time' in the individual strokes.
- 2. This competition is designed for swimmers who have not gualified to swim in the Welsh Age Group & Youth Long Course Championship in the current year. Please note that if a swimmer was eligible to swim in ANY event in the Swim Wales Age Groups & Youth Long Course Championships in the current year then they are NOT eligible to swim in ANY event in the Junior Development competition.
- 3. Relays: Only swimmers who have entered individual events in this Junior Development Meet can be considered by the clubs for their relay teams.
- 4. The entry fee for the Junior Development (Pentathlon) Meet will be £17.50. This fee covers all 5 swims. No reduction will be given for swimmers who enter less than the 5 events.

The entry fee for the Junior Development Meet – Relay Events will be £8.00. Clubs may enter up to 2 teams per relay event.

Please note that no refund of entry fees will be made for withdrawals after the closing date (Monday, 21st May, 2018) except with a doctor's note. In this situation the doctor's note will only be accepted up until mid-day on the day before the start of the meet. Notes received after this time will not be considered for refunds.

- 5. All events will be HDW.
- 6. Age shall be as on 31st December 2018.
- 7. In the event of a disgualification, the swimmer will be given the time of the slowest swimmer in that event (including disgualified swimmers) plus 5 seconds.
- 8. When all swims have been completed, each swimmers' time for the 5 events will be totalled up and ranked from fastest to slowest.
- 9. Swimmers will be accepted up to the maximum possible. If entries exceed capacity the meet organisers reserve the right to limit entries with the swimmers who have entered all 5 events being given priority. In the situation where the meet is still oversubscribed the meet organisers reserve the right to use their discretion to reduce numbers. Any swimmers not accepted will have their fees returned. Refunds will be available to each club on the day of the License No: 3WL180062

meet and may be collected from the meet office after the start of the warm-up for the final session.

- 10. No alcohol or tobacco advertising is permitted on any clothing.
- 11. All decisions made by the Meet Director will be final and binding.

Entries

Entries from clubs should be accompanied by a Payment Summary Sheet and a SINGLE cheque to cover all entries and coach/chaperone poolside passes. Cheques should be payable to "Swim Wales - West Wales Region".

Please note that entries will be refused if:

- they are received without the relevant fee
- they are completed incorrectly (Membership number must be included)
- they are received after the closing date of Monday, 21st May 2018.

Age Groups

Age groups for both Boys and Girls will be 9 Years; 10 Years; 11 Years; 12 Years.

Boys & Girls: 9 Years 50 meters for Butterfly, Backstroke and Breaststroke 100 meters Freestyle 100m Individual Medley

Entry Fees

The entry fee for individual swimmers in the Junior Development (Pentathlon) Meet will be ± 17.50 . This fee covers all 5 swims. No reduction will be given for swimmers who enter less than the 5 events

Entry fee for relay events is £8.00

Medals and Awards

Individual events:

In the Pentathlon competition, awards will be given to the swimmers ranked from 1st to 8th on the ranking list produced for each age group for boys and girls when the cumulative times from all five events have been collated. *Awards will not be given for individual events within the pentathlon*.

Relay events:

In the Relay Events, awards will be given to the first 3 teams in each age group.

Failure of a swimmer or deputy to attend the appropriate presentation will result in the swimmer forfeiting his/her award.

Spectators

Admission charges:

£3.00 per session £7.00 per day

Please Note: The Spectator Area must be cleared at the end of each session

Car Parking

The Wales National Pool Swansea has a car park facilities on site with 250 parking spaces. This is managed by the WNPS site staff. The car park facility is limited and events can fill the car park quickly. Please be aware that the car park is busy on event days. Swim Wales advises that drop off's and pick up's are arranged where possible to minimize cars on site.

Swim Wales has an allocated car park area for staff and volunteers, including officials. It is important that these spaces are reserved for staff and volunteers to ensure smooth running of the meet. Please do not park in these reserved spaces. Parking in these spaces may result in a car park ticket.

Mobile Phones

Mobile phones must **<u>not</u>** be used in the building at all.

Session Times

To be confirmed following receipt of entries. Confirmation of entries and session times will be sent via email.

General Conditions

This meet will be swum under the following rules and conditions:

FINA Technical Rules, Swim Wales Laws, West Wales Junior Development Meet 2018 Meet Conditions.

No alcohol or tobacco advertising is permitted on any clothing.

All decisions made by the Meet Director will be final and binding.

Swim Wales Regional Competitions Eligibility

- 1. Entries may only be accepted from competitors registered as members of clubs, holding either primary or multi registration Welsh membership within the West Wales Region.
- 2. Swimmers may only swim for one club during these championships.
- 3. Competitors must have been registered members of the club in whose name they are entered a minimum of 30 days prior to the closing date for entries for the championships (including relays).
- 4. Competitors who compete in ASA County Championships will not be accepted to swim in the following annual cycle of Regional Competitions:
 - a. The Junior Development Meet in May/June.
 - b. The Sub Regional Championships in November/December.
 - c. The Regional Championships in February the following year i.e. ASA County Championships in 2018 means they would not be accepted for the Swim Wales Regional Championships in 2019.

<u>Events</u>

Events will be held as shown on the attached programme of events.

Time trials will not be permitted.

All events are HDW.

Relay Events

Clubs may enter up to 2 relay teams per event. Each swimmer will be allowed to swim in one relay team in each event only.

Only swimmers who have entered individual events in this Junior Development Meet can be considered by the clubs for their relay teams.

Relay Forms must be submitted by the end of the FIRST warm-up session on the day of the event. Failure to do so may result in the disqualification of the team. A separate form must be completed for EACH team per event.

Swimmers names must be submitted in the swimming order. Relay teams failing to swim in the submitted order will be disqualified.

If it can be proved to the referee that a member of a Relay Team is incapacitated through ill health or accident, the referee may use his discretion and allow a substitute to swim.

Entries

The Organisers may request validation of any stated entry time.

In any event where entries exceed capacity, the meet organisers reserve the right to limit entries. Any swimmers not accepted will have their fees returned.

Officials

Each Club is requested to supply at least two qualified officials per session. Officials will be required to follow the protocol which can be down loaded from the Swim Wales web site.

Meet Procedure

<u>Heats</u>

Competitors will be seeded according to submitted times - slowest to fastest.

Coaches should ensure that swimmers make themselves available for marshalling at least 2 events prior to the event they are competing in.

Other conditions:

<u>Starts</u>

Over the top starts will, where necessary or appropriate, be used during the meet.

Passes

All Coaches and Chaperones who will be on the poolside at any time during the competition, must have individual accreditation obtained by completing the official form enclosed in this Information Pack. Completed forms must be accompanied by a passport size photograph.

Poolside passes will be transferable between coaches and chaperones *from the same club* who have completed an official accreditation form.

Accredited coaches and chaperones *from the same club* may use purchased poolside passes 'on rota', although the number of coaches and/or chaperones on poolside at any one time must not exceed the number of passes that have been paid for.

Passes will need to be worn at all times. Anyone without a pass will be asked to leave poolside/changing area.

The closing date for passes will be the same as the closing date for entries. Applications will not be accepted on the day.

Health and Safety

All competitors are required to ensure that they observe all safety announcements and conduct themselves with safety in mind at all times.

It is the responsibility of the swimmer and/or parent/guardian to declare to the referee any disability or medical condition that could present a health or safety risk.

If such a disability or medical condition exists, swimmers must produce a medical note confirming that their participation presents no health or safety problems.

In addition to the above meet conditions a number of Health and Safety rules as laid down by Swim Wales must be observed:

1. Unacceptable Behaviour

Behaviour becomes "unacceptable" when it is considered "Offensive" to others; this includes, but is not limited to, the following:

Theft, wilful damage to property and / or equipment, acts of vandalism, abuse of alcohol and / or drugs, bullying, offensive language, aggressive / violent acts, threatening behaviour, all breaches of safety practices, failure to comply with instructions / directions, actions that bring the sport of swimming into disrepute.

2. Competitive Start Award

Swimmers must have attained the standard of the Competitive Start Award in order to start from the blocks; (this is the responsibility of the club coach).

Swimmers who have not attained the standard of the Competitive Start Award must lower themselves into over the side into the water, on the long whistle of the Referee before starting at an appropriate place.

3. Jewellery

"For safety and security reasons, the wearing of jewellery is not permitted while in the water during warm-ups / swim-downs and / or competition. This includes watches, necklaces, chains, bangles, wrist bands, ear-rings (except studs), and rings (except wedding bands).

Swim Wales will not be responsible for any jewellery brought to events and will not be liable if such jewellery is lost or damaged."

4. Video and Photography.

Data Protection

The Region, along with the Governing Body, may use computers to record entry times and results. By submitting entries you are accepting the conditions and consent is hereby given for holding personal information relating to the sport of Swimming as required by the current Data Protection Act.

The organisers retain the right to amend these conditions if necessary, without notice.
