Please note that entries will be refused if:

- they are received without the relevant fee being paid
- they are completed incorrectly (Membership number must be included)
- they are received after the closing date of Friday 21st January 2022 at 17:00
- submitted entry times are slower than the consideration times or if a time of NT is submitted. Please note that in both of these situations NO entry fees will be refunded.

A random selection of submitted times will also be checked against the ASA Rankings Database. Entry times which cannot be confirmed in the database will be refused and NO entry fees will be refunded.

Qualifying Age Dates:

For ALL events the ages shall be as of 31st December 2022.

Medals and Awards

Awards will be made to the top 3 in each event.

Spectators

If Covid regulations allow spectators to be present at this meet then the admission charges will be:

General Conditions

This meet will be swum under the following rules and conditions:
FINA Technical Rules, Swim Wales Laws and Disciplinary Code,
Swim Wales Regional Championships 2022 Meet Conditions.

No alcohol or tobacco advertising is permitted on any clothing.

SWIM WALES REGIONAL COMPETITIONS ELIGIBILITY

1. Entries may only be accepted from competitors registered as members of clubs, holding either primary or multi registration Welsh membership within the West Wales Region.
2. Swimmers may only swim for one club during these championships.
3. Competitors must have been registered members of the club in whose name they are entered a minimum of 30 days prior to the closing date for entries for the championships. This also includes the relay events.
4. Competitors who compete in ASA County Championships will not be accepted to swim in the following annual cycle of Regional Competitions:
 - a) The Junior Development Meet in May/June.
 - b) The Sub Regional Championships in November/December.
 - c) The Regional Championships in February the following year i.e. ASA County Championships in 2021 means they would not be accepted for the Swim Wales Regional Championships in 2022.

All decisions made by the Meet Director will be final and binding.

Events

Events will be held as shown on the attached programme of events.

Time trials will not be permitted.

Entries

The Organisers may request validation of any stated Entry Time.

Please note that each event in this competition has a qualifying time and a consideration time. Those who have achieved the qualifying time are automatically eligible to compete in the relevant event subject to the following conditions:

- I. The number of competitors for the event does not exceed the maximum time available for that event.
- II. Acceptance does not extend the duration of the session beyond the session time limit imposed by the Swim Wales License.

Where possible, the faster times within the consideration range may also be accepted. Swimmers who meet the consideration time, but due to lack of space are not accepted, will have their entry fees refunded. Swimmers who submit NO TIME will NOT be accepted. Submitted entry times must have been achieved in a licensed meet in the period 1st January 2019 to the closing date (21st January 2022 at 17:00).

Please note that both short course and long course times are accepted for entry in this meet.

The meet organisers reserve the right to scratch entries based on times. Entries are not confirmed until the draft entry list is published after close of entries.

Officials

Each Club is required to supply at least two qualified officials per session. Officials will be required to follow the protocol which can be down loaded from the Swim Wales web site.
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Volunteers

As I'm sure you will appreciate, for any competition to run smoothly it is ESSENTIAL that we have a large number of volunteers to help with marshalling, announcing, 'ticket desk', etc, etc. The organisers would therefore be grateful if as many volunteers as possible would make themselves available for the competition.

Volunteers who are willing to help for all or part of the Championships are asked to contact Kelly Stokes by email (kelly.stokes1982@gmail.com) to indicate their availability for the meet.

Meet Procedure

Heats

- All events will be Heat Declared Winner (HDW)
- Events will be seeded according to submitted times.
- All heats will be swum **slowest to fastest**
- All heats will be spearheaded.
- The fastest 3 heats will be circle seeded.

Coaches should ensure that swimmers make themselves available for marshalling at least 2 events prior to the event they are competing in.

Other conditions

Starts

Over the top starts will, where necessary or appropriate, be used during the Meet.

Passes

All Coaches and Chaperones who will be on the poolside at any time during the competition, must have individual accreditation obtained by completing the official form enclosed in this Information Pack. Completed forms must be accompanied by a passport size photograph.

Poolside passes will be transferrable between coaches and chaperones from the same club who have completed an official accreditation form.

Accredited coaches and chaperones from the same club may use purchased poolside passes 'on rota', although the number of coaches and/or chaperones on poolside at any one time must not exceed the number of passes that have been paid for.

Passes will need to be worn at all times. Anyone without a pass will be asked to leave poolside/changing area.

Please note that poolside passes cover entry to the poolside and changing areas only. Entry to the spectator balcony is not included.

The closing date for passes will be the same as the closing date for entries. Applications will not be accepted on the day.

Health and Safety

All competitors are required to ensure that they observe all safety announcements and conduct themselves with safety in mind at all times.

It is the responsibility of the swimmer and/or parent/guardian to declare to the referee any disability or medical condition that could present a health or safety risk.

If such a disability or medical condition exists, swimmers must produce a medical note confirming that their participation presents no health or safety problems.

All swimmers, officials, volunteers, spectators, and visitors are required, at all times, to abide by the rules set out in the Pool Operating Procedures and / or the Normal Operating Procedures & Emergency Action Plan for the facility hired for the meet.

Unacceptable Behavior

Behavior becomes "unacceptable" when it is considered "Offensive" to others; this includes, but is not limited to, the following:

Theft, willful damage to property and / or equipment, acts of vandalism, abuse of alcohol and / or drugs, bullying, offensive language, aggressive / violent acts, threatening behavior, all breaches of safety practices, failure to comply with instructions / directions, actions that bring the sport of swimming into disrepute.

Competitive Start Award

Swimmers must have attained the standard of the Competitive Start Award in order to start from the blocks; (this is the responsibility of the club coach).

Swimmers who have not attained the standard of the Competitive Start Award must lower themselves into over the side into the water, on the long whistle of the Referee before starting at an appropriate place.

Jewellery

“For safety and security reasons, the wearing of jewellery is not permitted while in the water during warm-ups / swim-downs and / or competition. This includes watches, necklaces, chains, bangles, wrist bands, ear-rings (except studs), and rings (except wedding bands).

Swim Wales will not be responsible for any jewellery brought to events and will not be liable if such jewellery is lost or damaged.”

Photography

West Wales will adopt the Swim Wales Film and Photography Policy as shown below:

Swim Wales Film and Photography Policy

Please be advised that photographs and videos may be taken at this event.

Swim Wales are aware of the wide range of devices including mobile telephones which have photographic and filming capabilities. This enables the capture of both static and moving images. Used responsibly, such devices are perfectly safe, but sharing images widely may betray a confidence or identity of a child/children which may present a risk of harm to the child/children concerned.

The use of such equipment is difficult to control but we can all be vigilant. If you have any concerns or safeguarding queries, please bring them to the immediate attention of the event management team.

The West Wales Region may use photographs taken at this event as promotional material and used across public forums including their website and social media accounts. Should you wish to refuse photographic permission please contact the event management team on site. The full swim Wales photography guidance policy can be found on the Swim Wales website.

COVID:

Due to the ongoing and ever changing landscape, event management will confirm the use of mitigating risk considerations, such as Lateral Flow Testing, masks and social distancing prior to the commencement of the event. Swimmers are advised that adherence to any published rules, regulations and/or requirements imposed by Welsh Government,

Local Authority/Facility and/or Swim Wales is binding. Swimmers unwilling to adhere to the above will not be permitted site entry.

Streaming and social media:

The Swim Wales Regional Championships 2022 - West will be live streamed. The link for streaming will be confirmed and sent to clubs shortly before the meet. The stream will start at the beginning of each session over the meet. Please be aware that you and your swimmers may be watched by a large number of people. Please behave in a manner that has a positive reflection on you and your club.
