Competition rules and conditions

- 1). All events are HDW. Over the top starts may be used.
- 2). All swimmers must be members of Swim Wales.
- 3). Entries will be seeded slowest to fastest from submitted times. Heats will be mixed Male/Female.
- 4). NO late entries will be accepted.
- 5). Swimmers must report to Marshalling Area on poolside.
- 6). No refunds will be given unless a doctor's certificate is provided.
- 7). Only 4 club Coach/TM on poolside and must hold a pass which can be authorised prior to meet. Additional passes can be requested and will be reviewed by event management and a decision made based on the size of the squad.
- 8.). <u>Relays</u> Mixed events are any order eg Male Female Female Male or Male Male Female Female.. Swimmers entering relays must have been entered into the meet for an individual race. Maximum of two teams per event (A&B). Swimmers are unable to swim in A&B team of the same event.
- 9). Swimmers must have attained the standard of ASA Competitive Start Award in order to start from the blocks (this is the responsibility of the club coach).
- 10). Swimmers who have not attained the standard must lower themselves over the side into the water, on the long whistle of the referee, before starting at an appropriate place.
- 11). When a competition involves children under the age of 18 years of age it is a mandatory meet license requirement that all persons (including competitors/ officials / volunteers / spectators), wishing to engage in any kind of photographic activity including video, zoom, close range photography, irrespective of the nature of the device / equipment used for taking / recording such images must register their details with the event management in advance of taking any images. This can be done at the desk for entrance.

This includes but is not limited to:

Still Cameras, Cine Cameras, Video Cameras, Camera/video enabled mobile phones and Camera enabled PDA's

Proof of identity is required to register any photographic / video equipment. Please see below for the policy in full.

- 11). Jewellery, for safety and security reasons is not permitted while in the water during warm up, swim down or competition, Pembrokeshire County Swimming will not be responsible for any jewellery lost or damaged during the competition. This includes watches, necklaces, chains, bangles, wrist bands, ear-rings (except studs), and rings except wedding bands.
- 12). All participants must observe the safely precautions in operation at Haverfordwest Leisure Centre. Pembrokeshire County Swimming will not be responsible for any loss or damage occurring during this meet.
- 13). Any matters concerning the meet not covered in these rules will be dealt with according to the laws of the sport and at the discretion of the promoter. The promoter reserves the right to amend the Meet rules at their discretion.
- 14). Unacceptable behaviour

Behaviour becomes "unacceptable" when it considered "offensive" to others; this includes, but is not limited to the following:

Theft, wilful damage to property or equipment, acts of vandalism, abuse of alcohol or drugs, bullying, offensive language, aggressive/violent acts, threatening behaviour, all breaches of safety practices, failure to comply with instructions or directions and actions that bring the sport of swimming into disrepute.

In addition to this any swimmer who at the time of the gala is suspended from either Club, Performance Club or Swim Wales will be unable to swim at the meet and will not be entitled to a refund.

- 15) All Clubs are asked to provide 2 officials per session in order for the meet to be run to the license requirements.
- 16) Spectators will be allowed for this event as it stands. £2 per session. £5 per day. £8 weekend pass.
- 17) Scratches, In the event of over subscription, the event promoter has the right to scratch entries and/or change the schedule of events. In the 50-100m events priority for inclusion will be given to swimmers registered with a Pembrokeshire club, scratches will be at the discretion of the event management. In the event of over subscription in the 200m events, priority for inclusion will be given to swimmers registered to a Pembrokeshire club, after which scratches will be at the discretion of the event management.

The following photography policy is adopted from Swim Wales.

Please be advised that photographs and videos may be taken at this event. Swim Wales & PCS are aware of the wide range of devices including mobile telephones which have photographic and filming capabilities. This enables the capture of both static and moving images. Used responsibly, such devices are perfectly safe, but sharing images widely may betray a confidence or identity of a child/children which may

present a risk of harm to the child/children concerned. The use of such equipment is difficult to control but we can all be vigilant. If you have any concerns or safeguarding queries, please bring them to the immediate attention of the event management team. PCS & affiliated clubs may use photographs taken at this event as promotional material and used across public forums including their website and social media accounts, and possibly the local press. Should you wish to refuse photographic permission please contact the event management team on site. The full swim Wales photography guidance policy can be found on the Swim Wales website. There may be an official photographer at this event. If any parent does not wish their child to be photographed, please can you email pcs.galas@gmail.com by the closing date 31st May 2024.

The welfare, wellbeing and safeguarding of participants during this event is very important to the club and there will be a Safeguarding Officer in attendance throughout the meet.
