Competition rules and conditions

- 1). All events are HDW. Over the top starts may be used.
- 2). All swimmers must be members of Pembrokeshire County Swimming + their home club (H/West, Tenby, Milford, Fishguard or Pembroke).
- 3). Entries will be seeded slowest to fastest from submitted times. Heats will be mixed Male/Female.
- 4). NO late entries will be accepted.
- 5). Swimmers must report to Marshalling Area on poolside.
- 6). No refunds will be given unless a doctor's certificate is provided within 14 days.
- 7). Only 4 club Coach/TM on poolside and must hold a pass which can be authorised prior to meet.
- 8.) Skins finals & Relays— The top 8 male and 8 female swimmers will qualify for the A final regardless of age based on the 200IM results. The top 8 swimmers in the junior age sections (The age for JNR final will be published 7 days prior to the meet) & who did not qualify for the A final will be placed in the Junior final. Token prizes for the Junior Final, cash prizes for the open final. It is not possible to swim in both finals.

 Relays—Mixed events are any order eg Male Female Female Male or Male Male Female Female. 13/under & open age groups. We encourage clubs to swim it as 13/under and 14/over and use swimming up as a last resort. We ask clubs to take this into consideration when submitting relay teams. Swimmers entering relays must have been entered into the meet for an individual race. Relay teams will be capped based on entries and time.
- 9). Swimmers must have attained the standard of competitive Start Award in order to start from the blocks (this is the responsibility of the club coach).
- 10). Swimmers who have not attained the standard must lower themselves over the side into the water, on the long whistle of the referee before starting at an appropriate place.
- 11). When a competition involves children under the age of 18 years of age it is a mandatory meet license requirement that all persons (including competitors/ officials / volunteers / spectators), wishing to engage in any kind of photographic activity including video, zoom, close range photography, irrespective of the nature of the device / equipment used for taking / recording such images must register their details with the event management in advance of taking any images.

This includes; but is not limited to:

Still Cameras, Cine Cameras, Video Cameras, Camera /

Video enabled mobile phones and Camera enabled PDA's

Proof of identity is required to register any photographic / video equipment.

Please see below for the policy in full.

- 12). Jewellery for safety and security reasons is not permitted while in the water during warm up, swim down or competition. This includes watches, necklaces, chains, bangles, wrist bands, ear-rings (except studs), and rings. Wedding bands are permitted. Pembrokeshire County Swimming will not be responsible for any jewellery lost or damaged during the competition
- 13). All participants must observe the safely precautions in operation at Haverfordwest Leisure Centre. Pembrokeshire County Swimming will not be responsible for any loss or damage occurring during this meet.
- 14). Any matters concerning the meet not covered in these rules will be dealt with according to the laws of the sport and at the discretion of the promoter. The promoter reserves the right to amend the Meet rules at their discretion.
- 15). Unacceptable behaviour

Behaviour becomes "unacceptable" when it considered "offensive" to others; this includes, but is not limited to the following:

Theft, wilful damage to property or equipment, acts of vandalism, abuse of alcohol or drugs, bullying, offensive language, aggressive/violent acts, threatening behaviour, all breaches of safety practices, failure to comply with instructions or directions and actions that bring the sport of swimming into disrepute. Should a swimmer be suspended from club activities for any reason they will be unable to race at this meet. There will be no refunds for swimmers on a suspension.

- 15) All Clubs are asked to provide 3 officials per session in order for the meet to be run to the license requirements.
- 16) Spectators will be allowed for this event as it stands. £2 per session. £5 per day. £8 weekend pass.

The following is adopted from Swim Wales.

Please be advised that photographs and videos may be taken at this event. Swim Wales & PCS are aware of the wide range of devices including mobile telephones which have photographic and filming capabilities. This enables the capture of both static and moving images. Used responsibly, such devices are perfectly safe, but sharing images widely may betray a confidence or identity of a child/children which may present a risk of harm to the child/children concerned. The use of such equipment is difficult to control but we can all be vigilant. If you have any concerns or safeguarding queries, please bring them to the immediate attention of the event management team. PCS & affiliated clubs may use photographs taken at this event as promotional material and used across public forums including their website and social media accounts, and possibly the local press.
